






Dear Presidents and Secretary Generals,

Qualifications:

- -Holder of National black belt or Kukkiwon Dan Certificate
- -Recommendation letter by the National Taekwondo Association
- -2017 Approved WTF Global License for all athletes and team officials

Note: Member National Associations' application should be made at least 2 months before the Tournament starts to ensure the WTF license can be processed and approved in time. There will be **NO** WTF Global License registration onsite.

- Holder of the nationality of the participating team

Registration:

Registration is <u>only</u> accepted through the WTF Event Registration system https://www.hangastar.com/WTF/ and required for all participants to be uploaded and approved by the National Federation and WTF before you are able to register your team through the WTF Event Registration System.

For ALL participants (athletes and officials)

- 1. Valid National ID or Passport of the National Federations you are registering for a WTF Global License.
- 2. Color Portrait ID picture.

Entry Fees







The Organizing Committee shall collect the entry fees from the participating teams cash in US\$ only.

Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION FEES: A discount will be given to participants that complete their registration during this period.

- 350 USD per team
- Discounted entry fee period will **begin** on February 1, 2017, 17:00 local time in Tehran).
- Discounted entry fee period will **end** on February 15, 2017, 17:00 local time in Tehran).

REGULAR REGISTRATION FEES: The participants completing their registration during this period will be charged the regular registration fee.

- 400 USD per athlete.
- Regular entry fee period will **begin** on February 15, 2017, 17:01 local time in Tehran).
- Regular entry fee period will **end** on March 15, 2017, 17:00 local time in Tehran).

LATE REGISTRATION FEES: In the case a late registration period is opened the participants completing their registration during this period will be charged this fee.

- 450 USD per athlete.
- Late registration fee period would **begin** on March 15, 17:01, 2016 local time in Tehran).
- Late registration fee period will **end** on March 25, 2016, 17:00 local time in Tehran).







Competition Rules

WTF Competition Rules

KP&P Electronic Protectors will be used

Method of Competition Round Robin Tournament system

Competition Format

- 1- 7thAsian Clubs Championships will be held in the five weight categories announced by the WTF as a team competition and not individually.
- 2- Each team can have 2 athletes in each announced weight category. The players' names for each match should be submitted one hour before the beginning of the match.
- 3- The competition is held in 3 rounds.
- 4- Each country can have 2 teams but the host may have 3 teams.

A- The Preliminary Round

- In this round teams will compete in groups of 3 to five 5 teams.
- Each team will compete with the other teams in its group.
- The top team in each group will be based on their standings in the last Asian Clubs Championships or the latest ATU ranking and the other teams in the groups will be chosen by drawing.
- At the end of the preliminary round, the top eight teams will advance to the next round.
- Each win would give the winning team three (3) points.

In case two teams tie in the preliminary round, the winning team will be decided by result of the head to head competition in this round and will be announced as the winning team.

B- The Quarter Finals

In this round the competition will be continued in the following order:

- Pool 1- First team in group A vs. Second team in group B
- Pool 2- First team in group B vs. second team in group C
- Pool 3- First team in group C vs. second team in group D
- Pool 4- First team in group D vs. second team in group A

Starting this round the tournament will be single elimination and the losing teams will automatically be out of the competition.

C- Semifinals and Final

In this round, the matches will continue in the following order:

- Winner of Pool 1 against Winner of Pool 3
- Winner of Pool 2 against Winner of Pool 4







- The winners will advance to the final and the losers will play for 3rdplace.
- The reigning champion will enter the competition and will be added to the draw automatically.

Weight Categories

- Not exceeding 54kg
- Over 54 kg & not exceeding 63kg
- Over 63 kg & not exceeding 72kg
- Over 72 kg & not exceeding 82kg
- Over 82 kg

Age: All competitors must be 17 and above

Referees

NOTE: 1st, 2nd and 3rd teams will also receive CASH Prize.







International Referees

The following conditions shall apply:

- International Referees are required to pay for their own round trip airfare
- The OC will pay for accommodations from April 11-15 (4 nights).
- The OC shall pay a per diem of \$ 100 for each competition day.

Group Drawing:

The drawing of lots shall be conducted one day prior to the competitions with the presence of officials and representatives of participating countries.

Weigh-in:

Weigh-in will be conducted one day before the pertinent matches, and will be done once only

National Flag and Anthem:

Each participating team must provide the organizing committee two flags (size of 90 cm *140 cm) and the CD of National Anthem.

Transportation:

Please send your flight details to the OC no later than 18 March 2017 to enable us to arrange your transportation. The OC will provide transportation from Tehran's Imam Khomeini Airport to Sari and vice versa.

Arrival / Departure

Please send your flight details to <u>intl@irantaekwondo.com</u> for airport transportation arrangements.

Medical Control

- The WTF Anti-Doping Rules and where necessary the World Anti-Doping Agency shall apply throughout the competition.
- Compulsory anti-doping test will apply to all medalists while random tests will be conducted for other athletes.







Accommodation:

The Organizing Committee will provide <u>free accommodation and board</u> for all the participating teams.
